Independent Living

Communities of this type have a different kind of safety, access, and staff management issues than mainstream communities. You must provide a safe environment in a way that maintains the residents' dignity and independence. The safety measures must be present without being seen. TW Systems accomplishes this through a comprehensive wireless system. Our EV2 system can integrate with an existing system or as a stand alone system. Examples of capabilities include, but are not limited to:

- Location of resident known at any given time.
- Wireless call for help for residents and staff.
- Motion detectors in resident's room when resident hasn't moved in a specific time period.
- When resident leaves community in their own vehicle, an alert will notify staff if resident has not returned in a pre-determined period of time.
